Egg Tossing is a competition for pairs.

Find the A-frame board at the corner. Find the clip board attached to the A-frame and write the names of yourself and your partner on the page for one of the game times above. Make sure you read the disclaimer. Under 16's must have a parent or guardian sign.

Rules:

- Stand in the middle of town with everyone watching and photographing your every move and drop.
- Form two rows of up to 15 people, with a partners in each row facing each other.
- In round 1 the partners stand 1 metre apart and row 1 throws the egg to row 2. Any team whose egg is dropped is eliminated.
- Continue rounds, but each time taking 1 step further apart until only 1 team remains.
- Prizes will be awarded.
